CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

THIS CONFERENCE IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE PARTICIPANTS WITH STATE-OF-THE-ART TOOLS USED AT THE ONSET OF EARLY AUDIOLOGICAL INTERVENTION FOR INFANTS WITH HEARING LOSS. YOU WILL GAIN PRACTICAL INFORMATION ON THE NEWEST ASSESSMENT, MANAGEMENT AND FAMILY COUNSELING APPROACHES. THE CONFERENCE WILL FOCUS ON THE BIRTH TO SIX-MONTH PERIOD, AND THE TRANSITION FROM IDENTIFICATION TO THE ONSET OF EARLY AUDIOLOGICAL INTERVENTION.

- ✓ A BEST-PRACTICE PROTOCOL FOR INFANT AUDIOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT;
- ✓ TONE-BURST AUDITORY BRAINSTEM RESPONSE (ABR) TESTING OF INFANTS;
- ✓ INFANT AUDITORY STEADY STATE RESPONSES (ASSR) INCLUDING BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND CLINICAL APPLICATIONS;
- ✓ THE SELECTION AND FITTING OF AMPLIFICATION FOR INFANTS;
- ✓ FAMILY NEEDS DURING ONGOING AUDIOLOGICAL SERVICE PROVISION; AND
- ✓ A FAMILY-CENTERED APPROACH TO THE AUDIOLOGICAL MANAGEMENT OF INFANTS AND YOUNG CHILDREN WITH HEARING LOSS.

AUDIOLOGISTS, HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS, PARENTS, EDUCATORS, AND AUDIOLOGY STUDENTS WITH A BACKGROUND IN EARLY CHILDHOOD HEARING LOSS, WILL GAIN PRACTICAL INFORMATION REGARDING THESE CRITICAL TOPICS THROUGH LECTURE AND HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES.

KEYNOTE SPEAKER: W. JUNE HOLSTRUM, PH.D.

DR. HOLSTRUM DIRECTED THE EARLY HEARING DETECTION AND INTERVENTION (EHDI) PROGRAM FOR THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC) FROM 1999 TO 2002. SHE RECEIVED HER PH.D. IN EDUCATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA IN 1979. HER PRIMARY AREAS OF STUDY WERE INFANT AND CHILD ASSESSMENT AND INTERVENTION, AND PARENTING EDUCATION. DR. HOLSTRUM NOW SERVES AS A CONSULTANT FOR THE CDC EARLY HEARING DETECTION AND INTERVENTION (EHDI) PROGRAM.

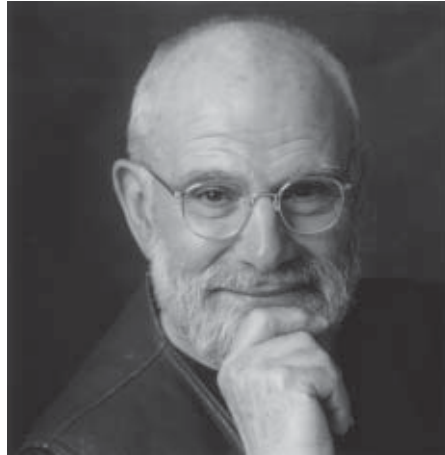

ONE OF THE GREAT MEDICAL WRITERS OF THIS GENERATION, HE HAS TRANSFORMED OUR UNDERSTANDING OF THE HUMAN MIND AND RESTORED NARRATIVE TO A CENTRAL PLACE IN THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE.”

DR. SACKS' LECTURE AND BOOK SIGNING ARE FREE AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

OLIVER SACKS BIOGRAPHY

AS A PHYSICIAN AND A WRITER, OLIVER SACKS IS CONCERNED ABOVE ALL WITH THE LINK BETWEEN BODY AND MIND, AND THE WAYS IN WHICH THE WHOLE PERSON ADAPTS TO DIFFERENT NEUROLOGICAL CONDITIONS.

OLIVER SACKS WAS BORN JULY 9, 1933 IN LONDON (BOTH OF HIS PARENTS WERE PHYSICIANS), AND HE OBTAINED HIS MEDICAL DEGREE IN 1958 FROM OXFORD UNIVERSITY. IN THE EARLY 1960s, HE MOVED TO THE UNITED STATES, WHERE HE DID AN INTERNSHIP AT MOUNT ZION HOSPITAL (UCSF) IN SAN FRANCISCO AND THEN A RESIDENCY IN NEUROLOGY AT UCLA. SINCE 1965 HE HAS LIVED IN NEW YORK, WHERE HE IS CLINICAL PROFESSOR OF NEUROLOGY AT THE ALBERT EINSTEIN COLLEGE OF MEDICINE AND CONSULTANT NEUROLOGIST TO THE LITTLE SISTERS OF THE POOR AND BETH ABRAHAM HOSPITAL.

DR. SACKS IS THE AUTHOR OF SEVEN BOOKS. HIS BOOK AWAKENINGS (1973), INSPIRED A PLAY BY HAROLD PINTER AND THE 1990 HOLLYWOOD MOVIE, AWAKENINGS, STARRING ROBERT DE NIRO AND ROBIN WILLIAMS. DR. SACKS IS PERHAPS BEST KNOWN FOR HIS BESTSELLING 1985 COLLECTION OF CASE HISTORIES FROM THE FAR BORDERLANDS OF NEUROLOGICAL EXPERIENCE, THE MAN WHO MISTOOK HIS WIFE FOR A HAT. IN 1989 HE RECEIVED A GUGGENHEIM FELLOWSHIP FOR HIS WORK ON THE NEUROANTHROPOLOGY OF TOURETTE'S SYNDROME, A CONDITION MARKED BY INVOLUNTARY TICS AND UTTERANCES. IN SEEING VOICES: A JOURNEY INTO THE WORLD OF THE DEAF, SACKS EXPLORES THE RICHNESS OF DEAF CULTURE AND AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE, SHEDDING LIGHT ON THE BASIS OF LANGUAGE.
